Underwriting Report:

At the end of December, 2010, Trillium has growth of 10.49%. Auto is up 15.58%, farm is up 3.89%, residential is up 10.32%, and commercial is up 9.58%. As of December 31, 2010, Trillium's combined ratio is 90.82% and the net loss ratio is 49.42%. There is an Underwriting Income of \$2,723,708.

Claims Report:

As of December 31, 2010, total incurred losses are \$16,473,737 which is down 3.7% compared to 2009. Total claims occurred in 2010 are 1384 which is down 15.6% from 2009.
