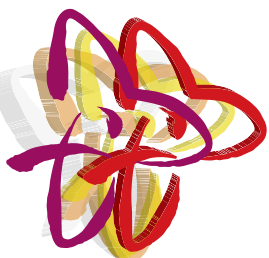
The Trillium Report

At the end of October, 2011, Trillium has growth of 3.33%. Auto is up 0.94%, farm is up 3.53%, residential is up 6.36%, and commercial is up 4.69%. As of October 31, 2011, Trillium's combined ratio is 92.22% and the net loss ratio is 53.87%. There is an Underwriting Income of \$2,062,786.

As of October 31, 2011, total incurred losses are \$14,076,849. Total claims occurred as of the end of October, 2011 are 1671.

Trillium supports . . . Habitat for Humanity

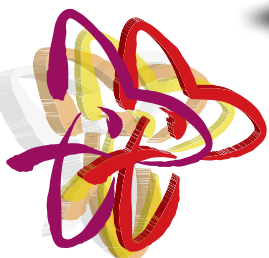
